Extra Credit is due at the beginning of class on Wednesdays.

I. Readings AND Reflections (5 points):

You will have one extra credit opportunity per week; it may be handwritten or typed. For extra credit, you can read the weekly assigned extra credit chapter. The documents will ALL be available in PDF form on our Blackboard course website and listed in the week modules, so you don't have to worry about buying the book. Each weekly submission will be worth 5 extra credit points per week.

Directions:

- Read the weekly assigned chapter from Roy Peter Clark. (These are found on Blackboard under each week's link.)
- Write five things you learned from reading the chapter. (Either in bulleted form or in paragraph form. Though you may use bullets, you must write in complete sentences.)
- Turn your answers into me at the beginning of class each Wednesday.

II. Bonus Questions on Tests (2-5 points):

On some tests, there will be an opportunity to earn extra credit points based on topics we have discussed during class. They will be, but are not limited to, questions about grammar, spelling, punctuation, and/or references to related videos shown in class.

Please be advised that extra credit will not be accepted after it is due. Additionally, even though there are many opportunities to receive extra credit, it would be wise to complete as many activities as possible. Extra credit has the power to turn a D into a C, a C into a B, and a B into an A.
