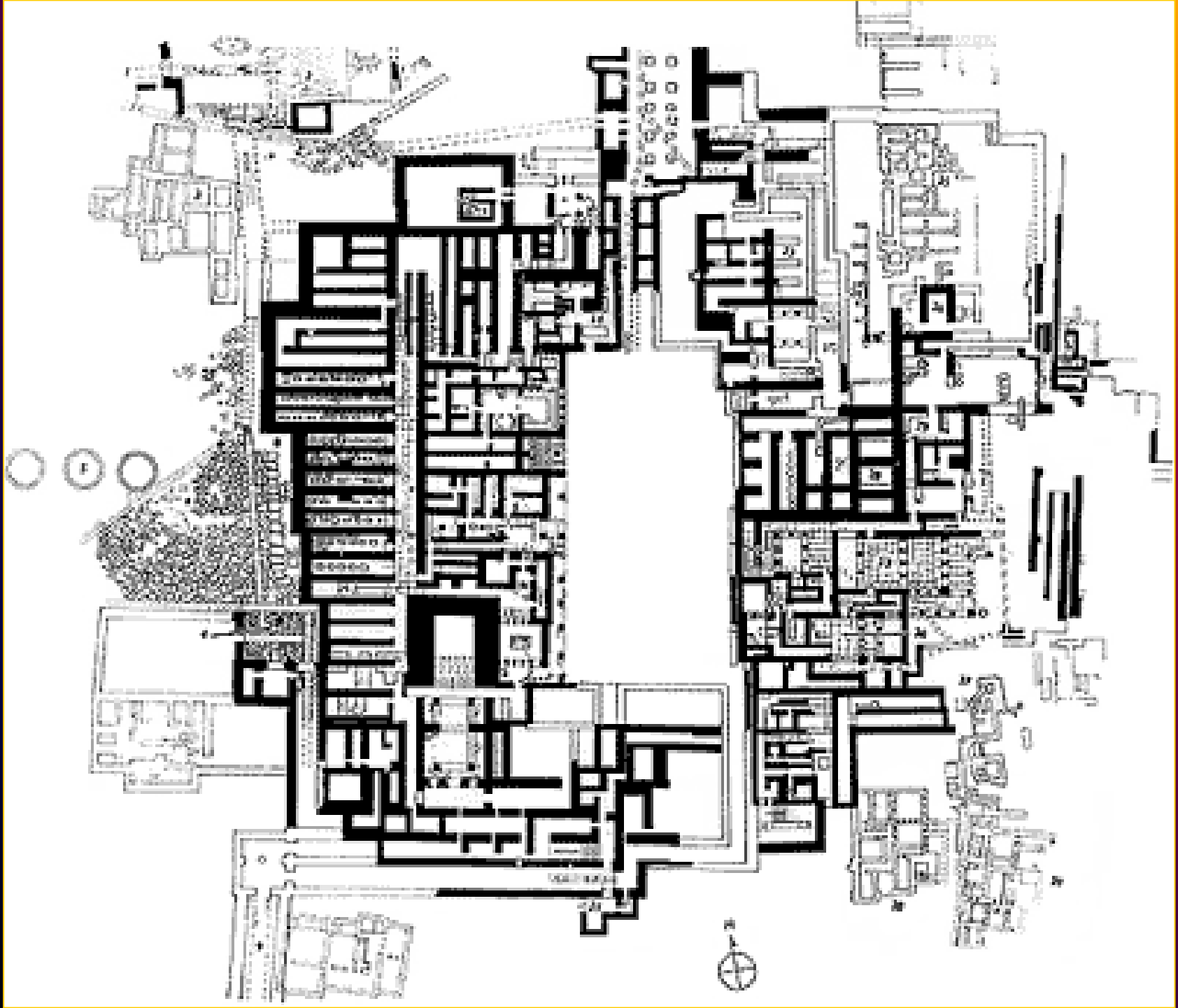


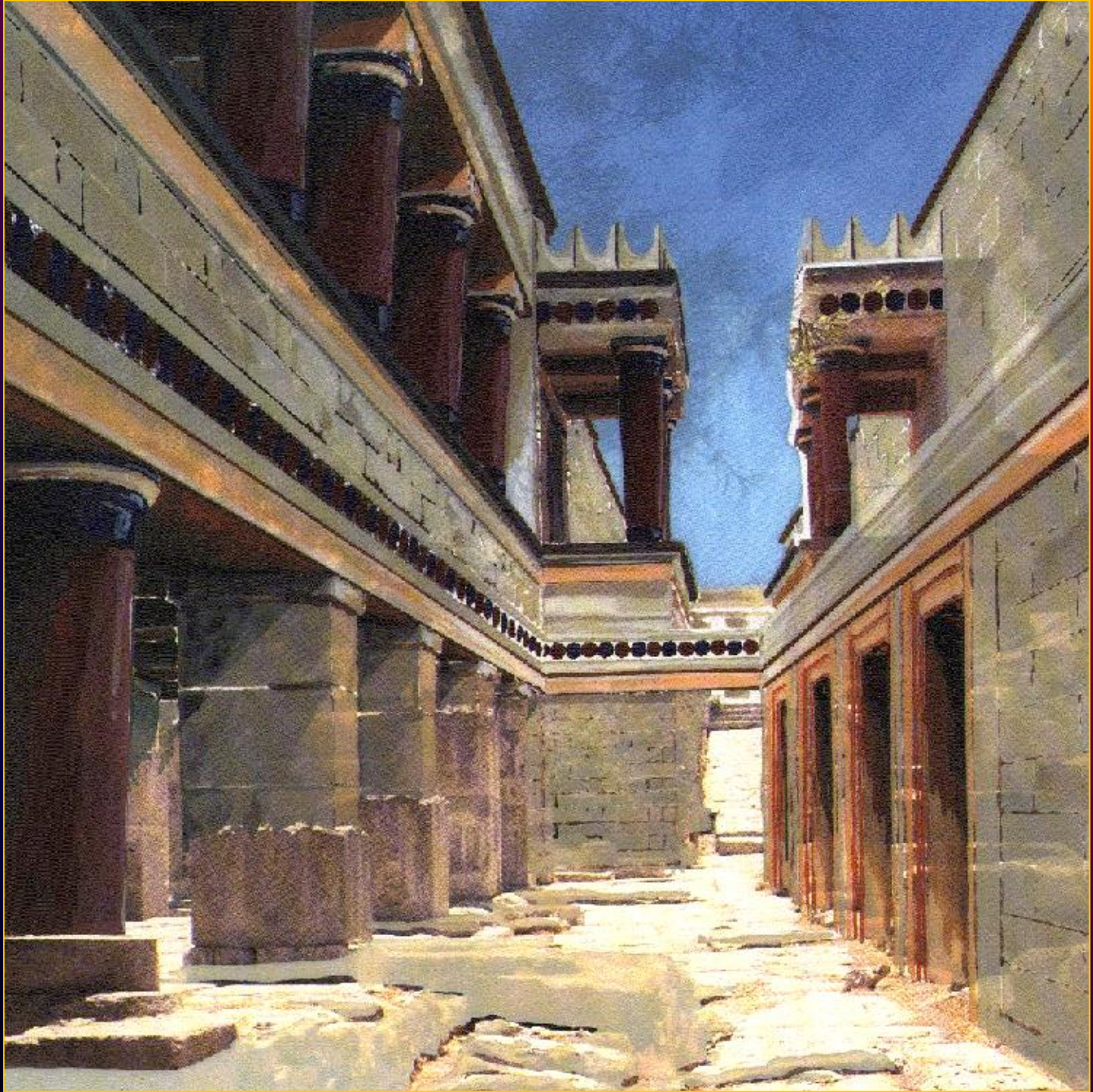
Knossos

On North-South Axis



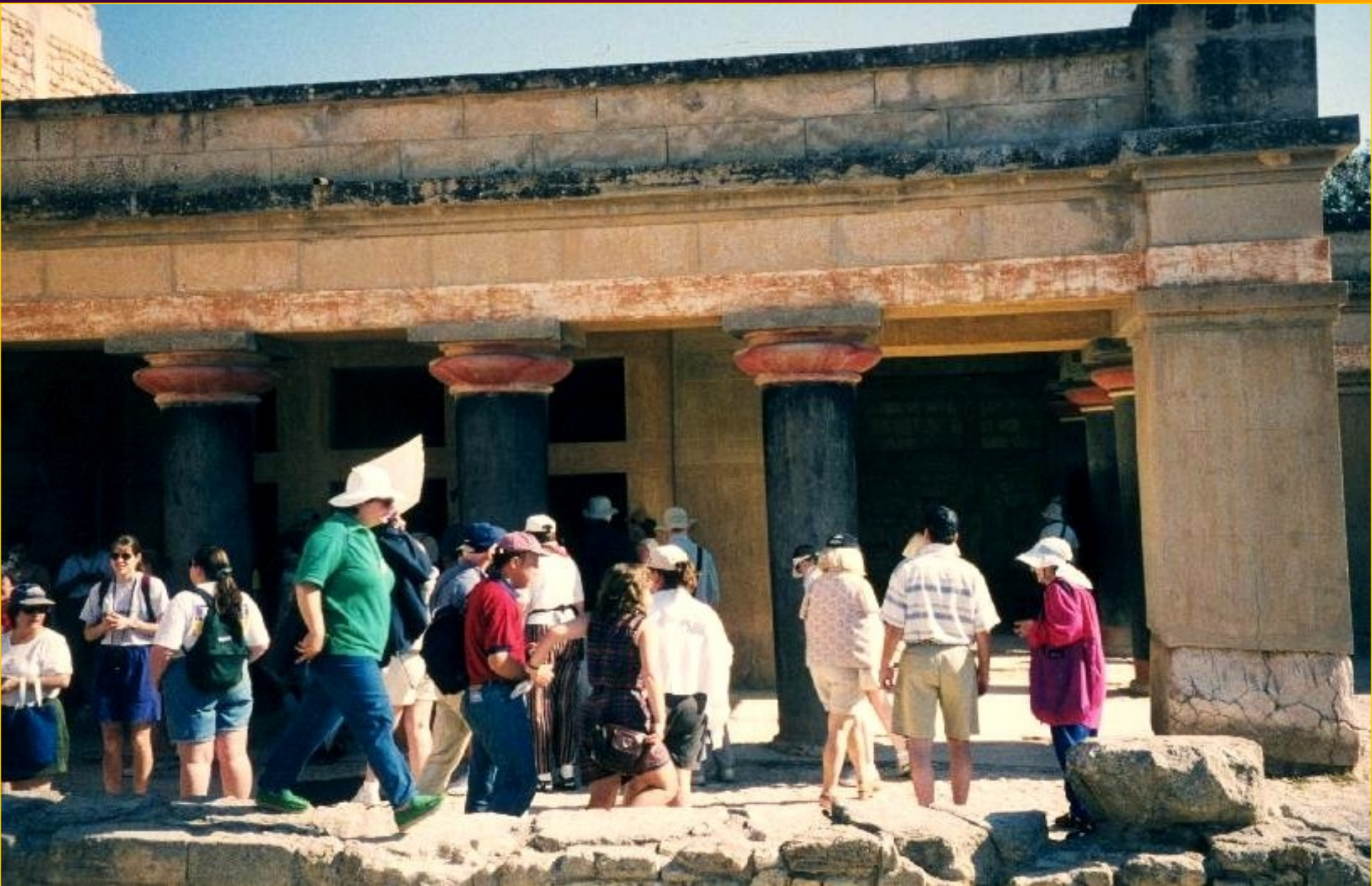

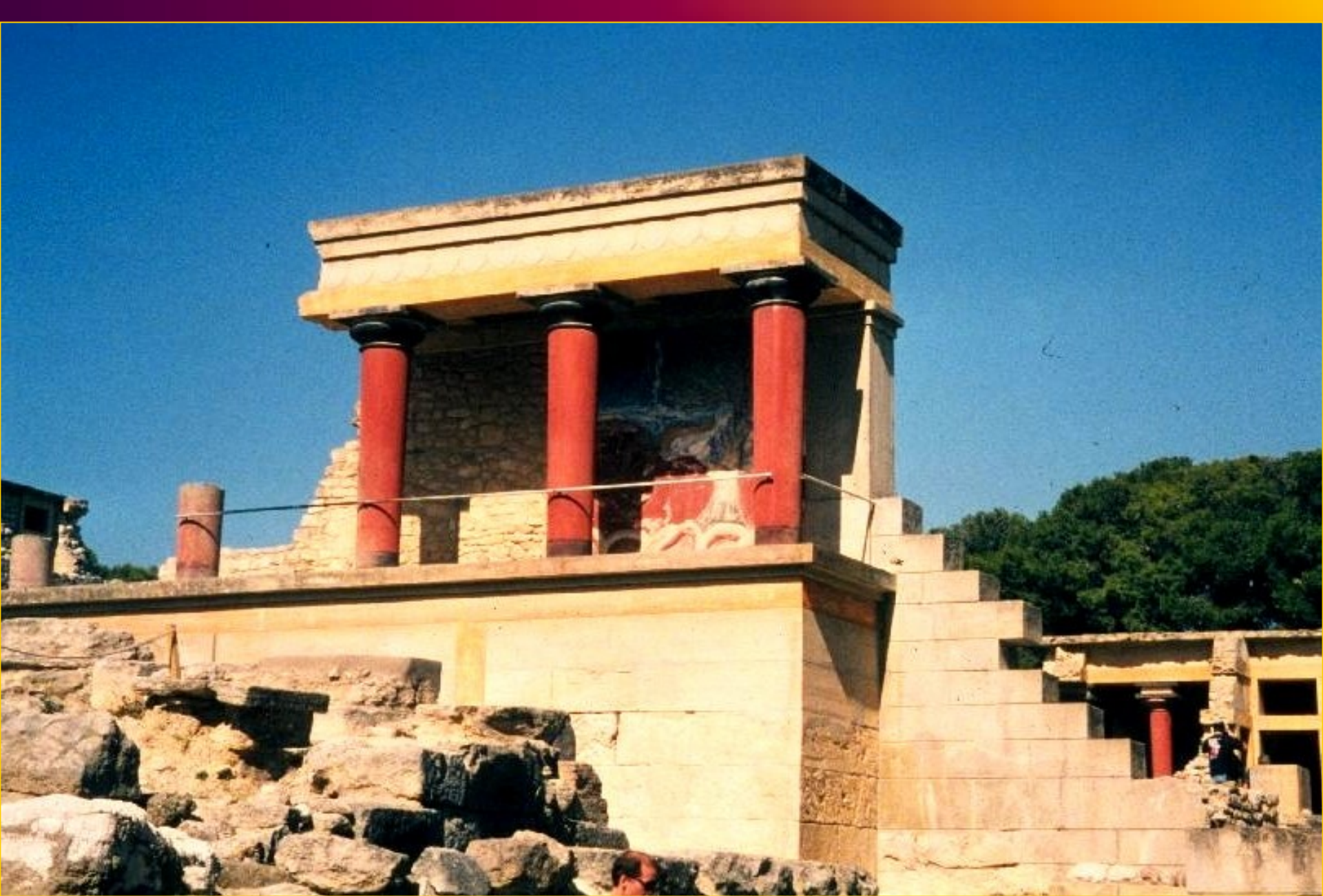

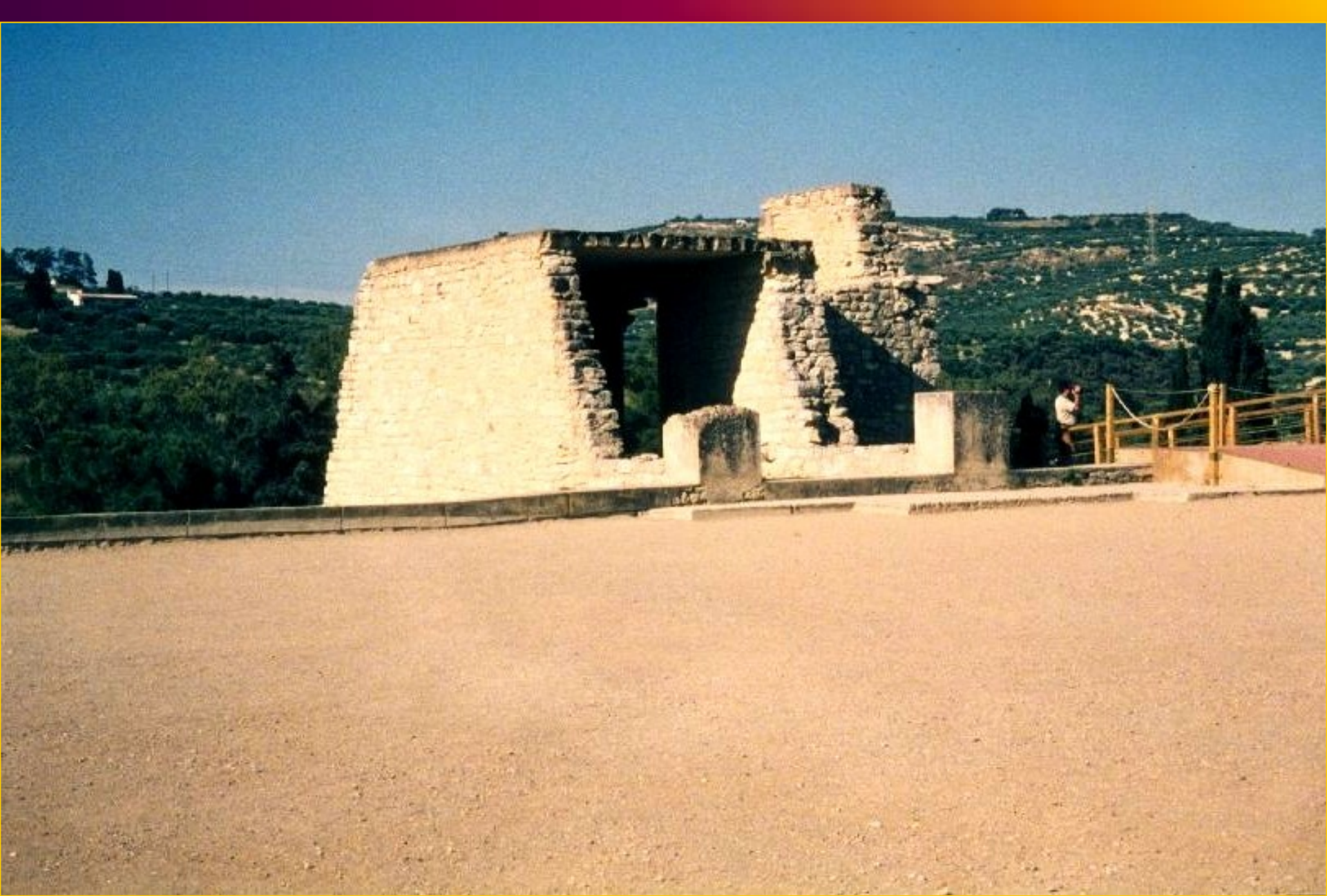

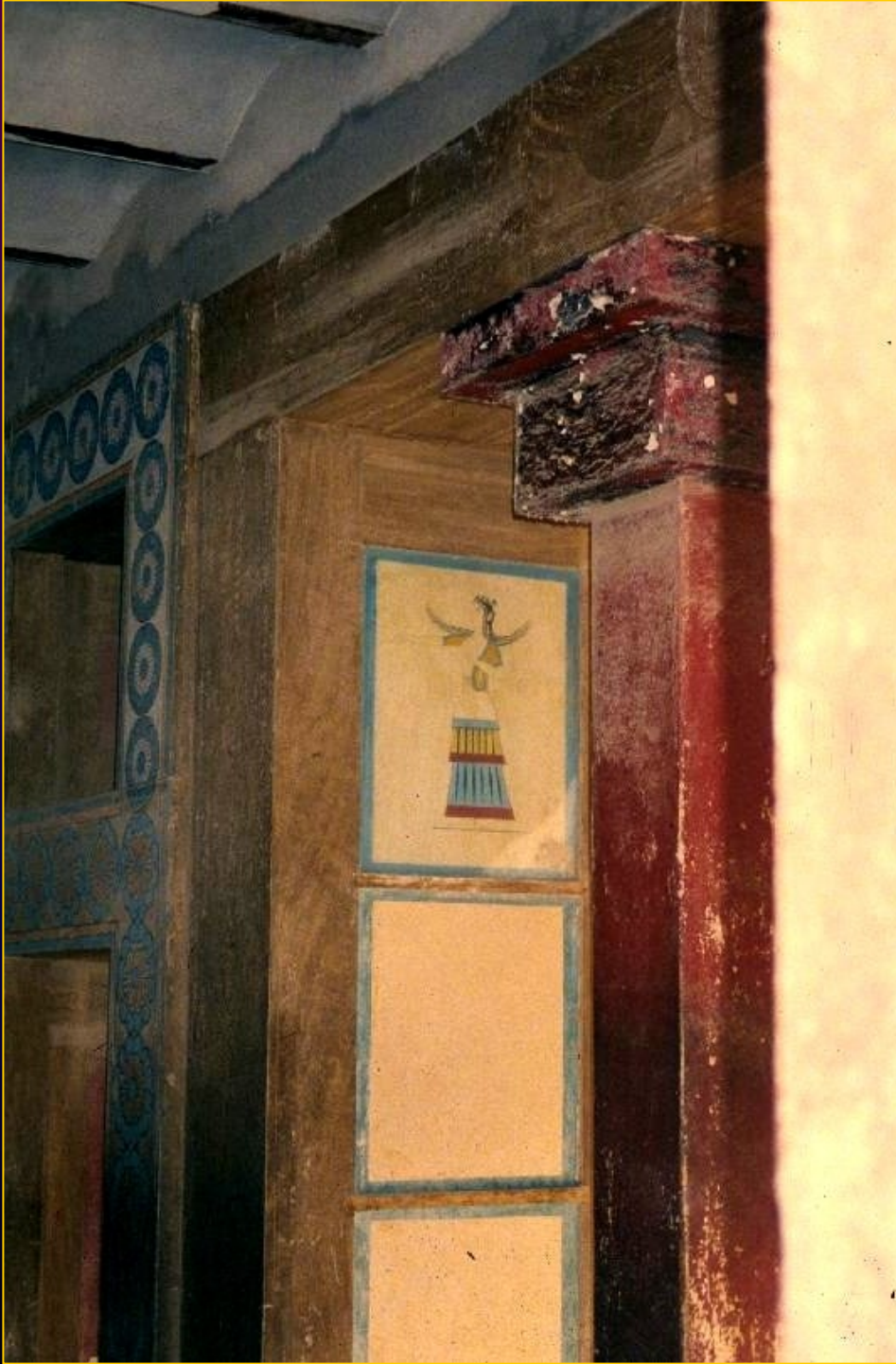
