62 B.C.-14 A.D.

- A. Grand nephew of Julius Caesar
- B. Will of Julius Caesar was read by Mark Antony, Octavian was in Greece
 - 1. Octavian became the adopted son of Julius Caesar
 - 2. $\frac{3}{4}$ of Caesar's wealth
 - 3. $\frac{1}{4}$ to the citizens of Rome
- C. Octavian's army defeated Mark Antony
- D. Second Triumvirate, 43 B.C.
 - 1. Octavian – Italy
 - 2. Mark Antony – Egypt
 - 3. Lepidus – North Africa
- E. Octavian joins with Mark Antony to defeat Brutus and Cassius in Greece, 42 B.C.
- F. Lepidus expelled in 33 B.C.
- G. Battle of Actium, 31 B.C.

- H. Octavian declared Emperor Caesar Augustus, 27 B.C.
- I. Pax Romana
- J. Died at age 76 in year 14 A.D.
