- 1 – **Abbot Suger / Abbey Church of St. Denis** (explain why this was done)
- 2 – **Gothic Architecture** (used for; originated when & where, why so different, explain how it glorifies God)
 - a. **Flying Buttress**
 - b. **Pointed Arch – Lancet windows**
 - c. **Gargoyle**
- 3 – **Notre Dame de Belle Verriere** – (*Translated as; part of; location; significance*)
- 4 – **Guild** (what is it, why important, significance of them in the Middle Ages)
- 5 – **Universitas** (*what is this, what did it do for education, what connection do we have with it today*)

 - C – Know what is meant by a Rose Window / and its relationship to honoring Mary
 - D – Know that travel for pilgrims is more important than ever
 - E – Know what *Lendit* means
 - F – Know about the history of Cathedral schools to the beginnings of the University schools
 - G – Know what a *Horarium* is
 - H - Know what is meant by *Chevet*
 - I – Know why many of the new cathedrals were dedicated to *Notre Dame*
 - J – Know that Peter Abelard is associated with the Cathedral School of Notre Dame of Paris; and
That St. Thomas Aquinas is associated with the University of Paris (same school just different times)
